



WANEP READY TO OBSERVE SIERRA LEONE'S PRESIDENTIAL RUN-OFF ELECTION

As part of preparations towards the Sierra Leone's Presidential run-off election slated for Saturday, March 31st, 2018, members of the WANEP Election Situation Room, comprising the eminent persons, data analysts, and information experts met on Friday 30 March 2018 at the situation room at Radisson Blu in Freetown to review experiences during the first-round of elections, and to re-strategize for the upcoming Presidential run-off election.

The meeting highlighted challenges with media engagements and advocated for more visibility of WANEP's election activities in Sierra Leone. Members advised that a multi-media communication strategy should be adopted to disseminate information to the development partners, the political stakeholders and the general public. The meeting underscored the need to have prior engagements with the two political parties to discuss their reception of the election results.
